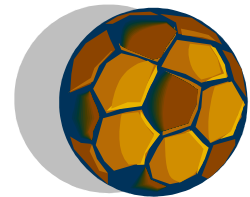




National Sports Week

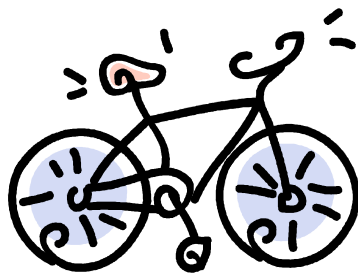

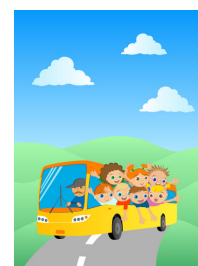
Year 2 enjoyed watching the dive show at The Deep and learning about underwater habitats and creatures.
