Geography – Investigating our local area.

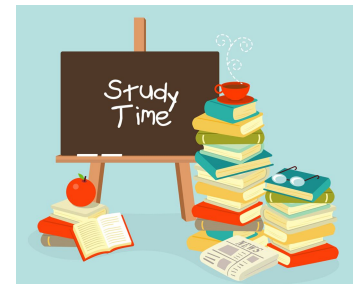
D&T – Photo frames.
