Menu Choice

Most schools offer the full menu however the menu choice at some schools has been reduced at the request of the head teacher, your school will inform you if this is the case at your school

Special Diets

We are able to cater for various diets (medical, cultural and ethnic) as well as food intolerances. You should contact your school in the first instance and then we will deal with it from there.

Who can claim free school meals?

Parents or carers in receipt of:

- Income Support
- Job Seekers Allowance (Income Based)
- Child Tax Credit with an annual income which does not exceed £16,190 and NOT claiming Working Tax Credit
- Guarantee element of State Pension Credit
- Children who receive Income Support or Job Seekers Allowance (Income Based) in their own right.
- Asylum Seekers receiving support provided under Part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999

In addition children must attend a school within Kingston upon Hull on a full time basis up to the age of 16 years or attend a sixth form school.

How do I apply?

The parent or carer who receives the qualifying benefit needs to complete an application form (form EWB1). Forms are available from all Customer Service Centres.

You can also obtain a form from your child's school or download a form from the Council's website. After filling in the form you can either:

Post it to Welfare Benefits (Municipal Buildings, Trippett Street, Hull, HU2 8AA), or

Some schools will check your form and then send onto the Welfare Benefits Team, please ask your school or Customer Service Centres will check your form and then send the Form onto the Welfare Benefits Team.

You do not need to send any documentary evidence of income with your form. We will make the necessary checks on your behalf.

Do I need to re-apply?

No, we will undertake checks on your behalf. Therefore free meals will continue to be available to your children throughout their school life unless your benefits stop or your asylum status changes. Should this occur we will write to advise when free meals will stop.

Change of circumstances

It is important that you let us know of any changes in your circumstances: eg Change of address, name, school, younger children starting school, or benefits stopping.
