Topics this half term



During Literacy this term we will be looking at sentence structure, flashbacks and dialogue, plays and poetry.

Science will involve Interdependence and Adaptation (plant and animal life) and Micro-organisms.

Our main topic for this term is India. The children will have chance to explore this topic through Literacy, Art and Design Technology, Dance and RE.
